Guest Speaker: Dean Anja Geitmann

Prof. Anja Geitmann, Dean of the Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences and Associate Vice-Principal Macdonald Campus, began by covering her past work history. She worked 14 years for Université de Montréal at the Montreal Botanical Garden. She is a plant cell biologist and will soon move her research laboratory and personnel to our campus. She has taught many courses and organized summer schools in microscopy. She did not come to Macdonald with a vision, but rather with a new set of eyes to potentially make changes.

A discussion followed where Council members informed the Dean on various needs of students. The main points covered were the shuttle, health services on campus (including mental health) and the new Student Life an Learning Building. On the shuttle, the main demand, considering that there will not be more financial resources, was to change the pick-up location downtown so that people waiting for the shuttle could do so in a warm place. As for health and mental health, the main demand was to provide summer services. Also, to work with downtown to obtain part of the funding they received from the Bell Let's Talk fund. Finally, the fear of MCGSS to see an athletics-centric building materialize was brought to the new Dean's attention.

- M. Kaji: The first MCSS Council meeting was mostly covering issues affecting MCSS alone. Their new website was discussed as well as Consent Week.

- N. Gaj: Bioresource engineering is facing serious space issues for its graduate students. Only some graduate students now have access to desks.

Business Arising

1. Peer Helper Program

N. Chatel-Launay explained that, because the PHP only received half of what was asked from the work-study program, they would need \$258.00 from MCGSS per term to close the year.

Be it resolved, That the MCGSS allocate \$258.00 per term from last fiscal year's savings to the Peer Helper Program.

Be it further resolved, That the MCGSS express concerns for the long-term sustainability of the program, and that it has a high cost per student helped.

Motion carried by unanimous consent.

- M. Kaji informed Council that MCSS has not voted yet on their part of PHP's funding.
- J. Singh demanded that MCGSS push McGill to contribute.

2. Graduate Orientation Wrap-up

- N. Chatel-Launay mentioned that orientation was a great success. Of the 227 new graduate students, 115 attended. 130 attended the BBQ.
- J. Singh proposed that PGSS and MCGSS work together for next year's orientation. One PGSS orientation activity should bring downtown graduate students to Mac.
- M. Kaji mentioned that, although we were supposed to have one, MCGSS had no table at the Redpath Hall orientation day. About 10 new students from Mac were there.

3. Ceilidh Drinks

N. Chatel-Launay mentioned that the last Ceilidh Drinks went very well and that all tickets went out in 7 minutes.
