- N. Gaj: The Bioresource department piggy-backed onto the PGSS sugar shack event, there were 50 students from BREE but PGSS couldn't get bus to pick up students at MAC.

**MCGSS** 

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- H. Galvez stated that if the departments encounter difficulties like this with PGSS, the departments should inform MCGSS. MCGSS will try to aid the departments in accessing PGSS services and support.
- M. Lin: Nothing to report.
- J. Singh: He gave an update on the resource economist search by the NRS department. He stated he would like to see more grad students attend the coffee sessions with the candidates and for grads to give him feedback on how they find the candidate.
- L. Michalovic: There will be a laser tag outing for animal science.
- Y. Schuermann: Nothing to report other than the previously mentioned laser tag outing.
- H. Galvez: He gave an update on PGSLF and showed all departments their current balance.
  - G. Limniatis: What happens to unused money?
- H. Galvez: The money is not meant to be saved, it is to be spent and as such left over funds must be budgeted by end of June by departments. If the PGSLF is not budgeted, MCGSS will re-absorb the remaining funds.
- J. Singh: We should email the departments (dietetics/food science/agricultural economics) that aren't at todays meeting in regards to the budgeting their remaining funds.
- H. Galvez went over the total budget. We kept in line with out budget fairly well. He is waiting for the peer helper support to invoice MCGSS. The AGM cost \$103.40. Hector paid this month for all ceilidh drinks and wine & cheese, alcoholic beverages costed around \$600.

#### **Business Arising**

#### 1. New executives for June 1st

The council went over introductions and welcomed the new executives at the beginning of the meeting.

### 2. AGM: Athletics Fee

- J. Singh: Went over discussion from AGM. MAC grads who live downtown and don't use the Macdonald gym facilities want to opt-out of the athletic fees. A member stated that downtown students have the option to pay for the gym.
- H. Galvez: Downtown also pays an non-opt-outable athletics fee plus an additional fee for access to certain facilities. MAC campus grads pay one fee that has more of a bang for our buck. We have access to both gyms except weight rooms downtown. We pay the same as downtown students and get more access. It would be hard for us to convince McGill to make the fee opt-outable.
- Additional concerns were raised that the MAC athletics fee could increase if it was opt-outable and that gym access is important to student health (mental and physical) and grad students should be using the gym (either downtown or at MAC). The fee is also a McGill auxillary fee so McGill controls the amount and opt-outable status.

#### 3. AGM: Extra summer bus

J. Singh goes over the details of the AGM question and history of shuttle service. Members asked that one additional bus be added to the summer schedule.

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G. Lambert-Rivest and H. Galvez stated the shuttle is never full. Adding a second bus is difficult and may not be needed. It also took about 10 years to get an additional bus to the regular school year schedule.

H. Byrne: raised the point that the summer schedule has a difficult schedule, specifically the evening bus from MAC to downtown that leaves at 6:30pm.

J. Singh: Should we pursue changing times instead of adding a new bus?

A secondary discussion followed on changing the departure times instead of adding a new bus. N. Chatel-Launay volunteered to make a survey to determine what times our members would prefer the shuttle leave.
